

VOTER ELIGIBILITY

FOR THE CONSEIL SCOLAIRE ACADIEN PROVINCIAL ELECTIONS


It is very important for voters to understand the eligibility criteria.

To cast a ballot for a Conseil scolaire acadien provincial (CSAP) board member, you must:

1. Meet the voter eligibility criteria for municipal elections; and
2. be an "entitled person".

An "entitled person" is an individual who is a **Canadian citizen** and who meets **one of the following criteria**:

1. Whose first language learned and still understood is French; **or**
2. Who received primary school instruction in Canada in a French-first language program; **or**
3. Who is the parent of a child who is receiving or has received primary or secondary school instruction in Canada in a French-first language program



IMPORTANT: Pursuant to the Education (CSAP) Act, the entitled person wishing to cast a ballot for a CSAP Board member simply needs to confirm their status as an entitled person by requesting the ballot to vote for CSAP.
