1. Call to Order – Co-chair, Councillor MacInnis

3. Opening Remarks and Roundtable Introductions

4. Regional Emergency Management Coordinator Report

Mr. Lam provided an overview of the Antigonish Regional Emergency Management Organization and the emergency management program. A review of organizational priorities and status of the emergency management program was presented with an outlook towards next steps moving forward.

5. <u>Municipal Emergency Management Assessment</u>

There was discussion regarding the Municipal Emergency Management Assessment tool from Nova Scotia Emergency Management Office. Results from the completed assessment will be shared with Nova Scotia Emergency Management Office on behalf of the Municipality of the County of Antigonish and the Town of Antigonish to identify short-term and long-term priorities of the emergency management program.

6. Comfort Centre & Emergency Shelter Policy

A revised Comfort Centre & Emergency Shelter Policy was presented for discussion and feedback. The Committee recommended the following actions:

- Municipality of the County of Antigonish the proposed policy revision will be directed to the Committee of the Whole for internal feedback and guidance before any community consultation.
- Town of Antigonish the municipality will work with the Antigonish Regional Emergency
 Management Organization to finalize policy details before it is introduced to Council in a briefing.

7. Additions to the Agenda

a. Access Road to St. Martha's Regional Hospital

There was discussion regarding the state of the former access road parallel to the railway and its availability for emergency vehicles or public vehicles in the event of a bridge closure.
